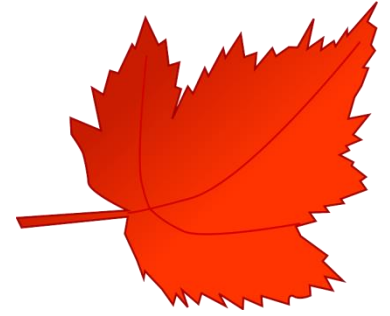




Mrs. Fredericksen's K4 Class
